The renovation, included a thorough upgrade of the existing building enclosure: new windows, wall-roof insulation, and new environmental systems. The inner spaces arranged around two green patios filter the natural light inside and guarantee privacy at street level. Communication and visual continuity between individual spaces was achieved by means of glass partitions and sliding panels allowing a functional and flexible use. The service areas including kitchen, pantry and larder were thoroughly revamped with finishes in tola wood and polished marble stone. Shelving, storage and inset equipment were included in the design.
